

„Dr Đorđe Natošević“ Award

On the celebration of Teachers' Day, 8th November 2007, in the Parliament of Vojvodina Province in Novi Sad our school, Tehnička škola from Kikinda, got a award „Dr Đorđe Natošević“ for remarcable results in education for two previous school years. The award was handed by Jegeš Zoltan, Minister of education and culture of Vojvodina. Tehnička škola from Kikinda was the first one from the territory of Vojvodina to get this award which consists from a diploma, medallion and 400,000 dinars. After our school, two other schools got recognition too, they are Commerce school from Sombor and Music school “Isidor Bajić” from Novi Sad. According to headmaster of our school, Milovan Ćurčić, Tehnička škola from Kikinda sent 700 pages of report about the activities and results we achieved in that period.

There were 32 applications, and we are honoured to be chosen as the best. We collaborate with 33 firms in Kikinda very successfully, either with private and state firms, where our pupils get practical training. We have a pleasent cooperation with Ministry of Education of our state and with Ministry of Education and culture of Vojvodina Province.

This high recognition in achievements in education was founded by the resolution of the Parliament of Vojvodina i Province n 1996. It is given to pre-school institutions and to schools and their employees from Vojvodina Province for exquisite results in organization of educational processes, and for affirmation of collaboration, coexistence and enjoying the differences and applying the contemporary methods. All the effort is made to induce better and high-quality work .

Đorđe Natošević – teacher and reformer

Đorđe Natošević was born in Slankamen in 1821. He attended Karlovačka gimnazija. He studied philosophy in Szeged and medicine in Budapest and Vienna. Under the influence of bishoup Platon Atanacković he decided to work as a teacher. He was a teacher and a headmaster of Novosadska srpska gimnazija. He is remembered as tireless reformer of serbian schools in Habsbur monarchy, at the time. Offered by the Duke Mihajlo Obrenović, he worked as an administrator in Ministry of Principality of Serbia. He was also managing Matica srpska for a certain time.
